The owner, rider and any other agents or representatives acknowledge that they participate voluntarily in the competition fully aware that horse sports and the competition involve inherent dangerous risk, and that by participating they expressly assume any risks of injury and loss, and they agree to hold the competition and its officials, directors, employees harmless. All horses will be exhibited at the owner/lessee's risk.

Bainbridge Island Saddle Club Rules and Regulations

- 2 Approved helmets are required for all riders when mounted.
- 3 All riders who have not reached their 18th birthday must be accompanied by an adult (18 and over) when riding.
- 4 Jumping is allowed only with trainer supervision.
- 5 No dogs in the arena; dogs on BISC grounds must be leashed.
- 6 If equipment is damaged do not use it and remove it from the arena.
- 7 Ride safely and courteously:
 - o Keep your horse under control at all times
 - o Pass left shoulder to left shoulder when traveling in opposite directions
 - o Give the right of way to horses that are jumping
 - o Halt if a rider falls off a horse
